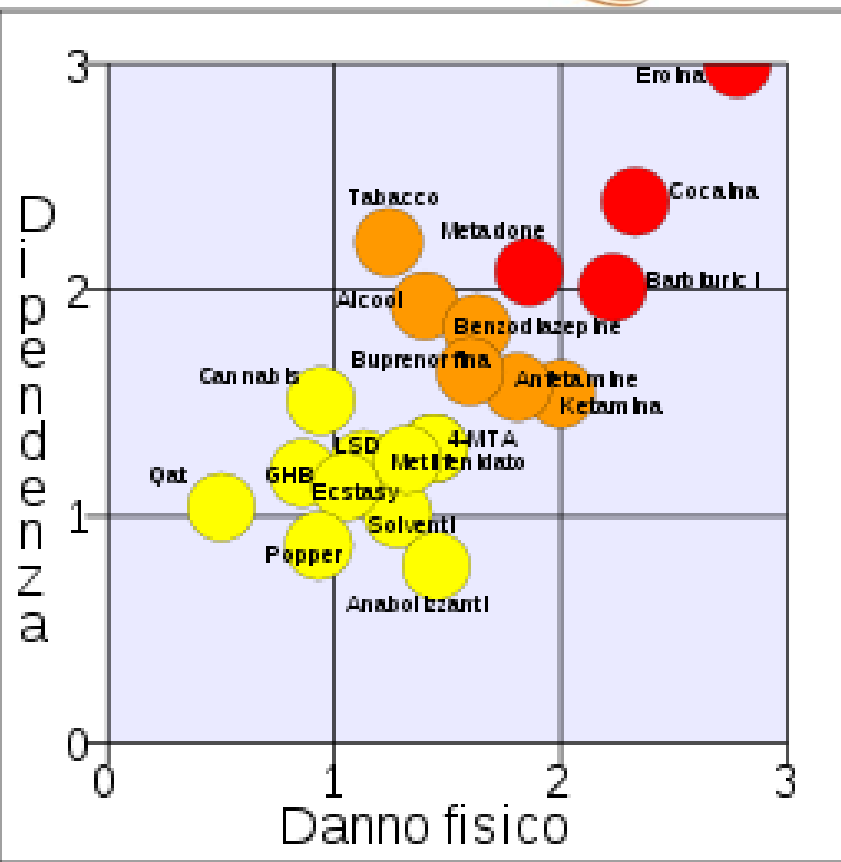

Contesto

Pre-adolescenti

I preadolescenti (11-14 anni) ed i giovani rappresentano una popolazione particolarmente a rischio di abuso di alcol, in quanto spesso percepito come mezzo di accettazione all'interno del gruppo. Da un punto di vista psicologico, l'uso e l'abuso di alcol tra i preadolescenti è spesso innescato da fattori di fondo legati alla **costruzione dell'identità**, all'**accettazione da parte del gruppo**, al **conformismo con il mainstream**, alla **paura dell'esclusione**, al **bullismo**, ai **riti di passaggio**, alla **sfida all'autorità**, ecc. La preadolescenza è caratterizzata anche da un maggiore **utilizzo di dispositivi elettronici** (es. smartphone, computer, videogiochi), di servizi internet (es. social media, Internet, videogiochi basati su Internet, ecc.) e da una maggiore autonomia nella propria vita. La vita familiare e sociale, tutti fattori che giocano un ruolo nel formare la mente dei giovani.

Adulti

Allo stesso tempo, **gli adulti, compresi i genitori e gli educatori**, che dovrebbero avere la responsabilità di guidare ed educare i giovani, faticano a confrontarsi con il problema dell'abuso di alcol tra i preadolescenti. Da un lato non sono consapevoli del problema perché pensano che sia qualcosa che riguarderà i giovani in una fase successiva. Dall'altro, **non sanno come affrontarlo**: hanno **difficoltà a leggere i segnali di comportamenti potenzialmente rischiosi** e, quando rilevano una situazione di consumo o abuso di alcol, **non sanno come affrontarla**.

Il progetto si rivolge direttamente ai ragazzi e alle ragazze pre-adolescenti che frequentano la scuola, in quanto rappresentano il miglior gruppo target per prevenire in una fase iniziale l'abuso di alcol e altri comportamenti a rischio. Allo stesso tempo, anche i genitori, gli educatori e il personale di supporto psicologico vengono presi di mira direttamente in quanto rappresentano i due attori maggiormente coinvolti nella crescita e nell'educazione dei giovani tra gli 11 e i 14 anni.

- fornire agli utenti finali competenze e informazioni riguardanti il tema dell'abuso di alcol tra gli studenti.

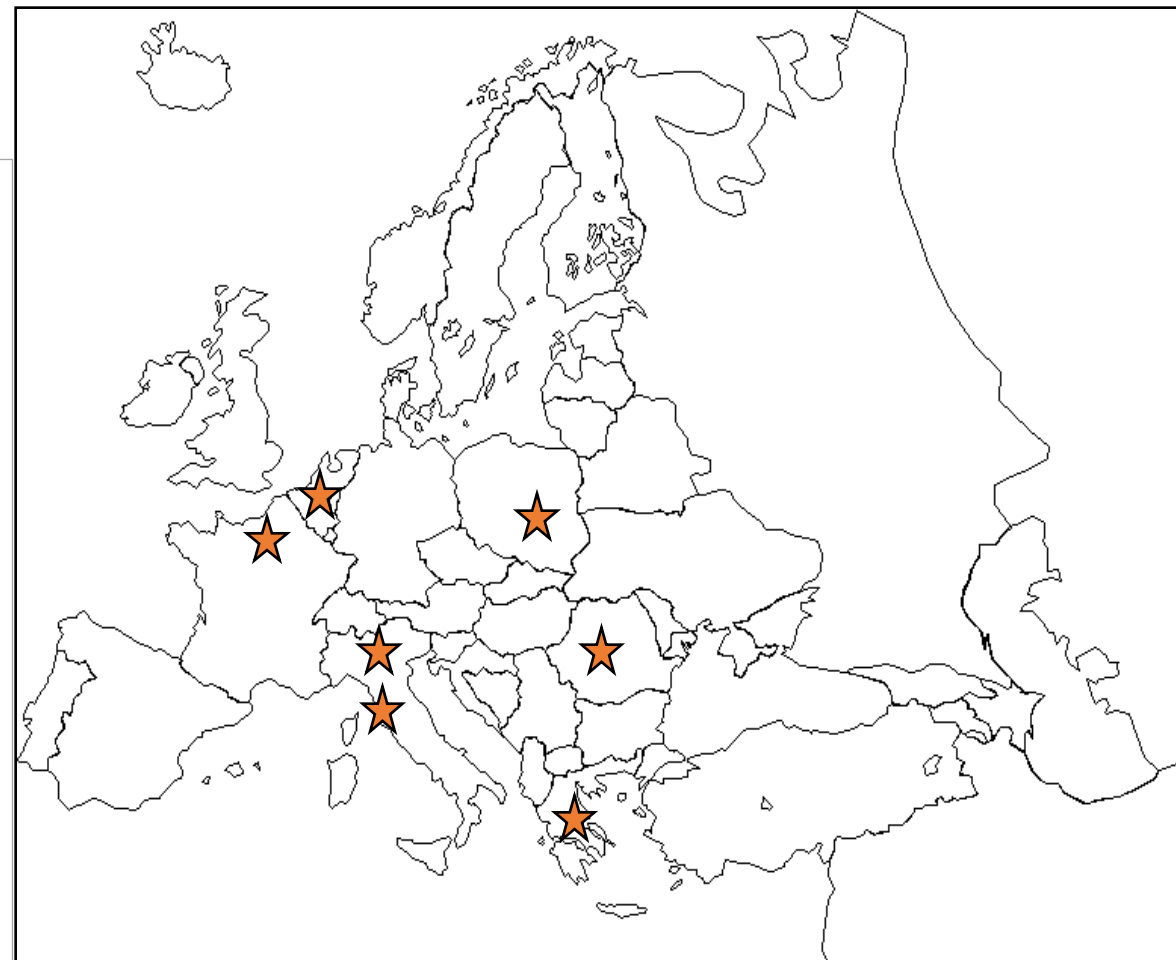

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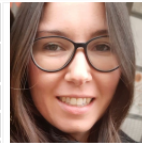
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Description of the organisation

In the seventies, a group of Rotary Clubs and Lions Clubs from the Lombardy region created AIDD, an organization of volunteers for the prevention of youth distress.

In recent years, AIDD has expanded its activities by addressing new issues of youth distress, including drugs, alcohol, bullying, cyberbullying, smoking, video games, the internet, game therapy, gambling, anorexia, bulimia.

The inspiring principle is to take responsibility for the "primary prevention of youth distress", only partially supported by the institutional authorities, which is expressed in the recognition of risk factors and identification of the actions aimed at preventing, mitigating or eliminating them. In addition, the motto of the association is "to serve" the people, in this case the youth, in need, as inspired by founding members. AIDD's prevention activities take a strong pedagogical and educational angle, thanks to the contribution of its staff composed of psychologists, pedagogists, pharmacologists and legal personnel.

Over the years, AIDD has specialised in the following areas of intervention:

- Information, awareness raising and training courses aimed at reinforcing education and psychophysical health of young people in primary and secondary schools, ensuring the involvement of teachers, pupils and parents and with the use of "pedagogical itineraries" developed by expert psychologists and pedagogists
- Organization of conferences and forums, aimed at implementing the level of awareness of authorities, institutions and operators involved in the youth field. AIDD focuses especially on youth as a tricky developmental age, which requires strong, concrete and timely interventions to avoid degenerating towards the "deviance" of the risk factors identified at embryonic level
- Organization of events, also with fundraising purposes, aimed at institutional activities

Just to give an example, during the 2018/2019 academic year, AIDD has implemented educational pathways targeting 3.725 students, 460 teachers, 1.550 parents, for a total of 1.100 educational hours.

Experience of the organization in previous European projects

None.

Experience and Expertise of the organization in the project's subject area

In the past three years, AIDD has conducted, at regional level, the project titled "La Vita in un Sorso", an educational programme expressly developed to address alcoholism among the youth. Almost 2.000 people, including students, parents and teachers, have benefited of this project so far, reporting high rates of satisfaction and relevance.

AIDD has conducted La Vita in un Sorso in the following schools: Tolstoj, Cardarelli, Pisacane Poerio, Murnari, Cantù, Calassanzio, Rinnovata Pizzigoni, Capponi, Mauri in the municipality of Milan, and in primary and secondary schools in Lombardy region, namely in the towns of Cinisello B.mo, Arese, Erba, Sesto San Giovanni, Melegnano, Concorezzo, Trezzo sull'Adda, Garbagnate, Rho.

The schools where AIDD has worked have provided with testimonials from teachers, parents and pupils who are in favour of replicating the courses, as they have felt involved, thanks to the adopted methodology developed and implemented by their pedagogists, psychologists, pharmacologist and lawyers.

Awareness raising events have also been organised in various departments of the municipality of Milan. These events are open to the public and they engage key stakeholders and policy makers.

Contributions that can be provided to the project

AIDD will play a two-fold role in the CUT! project.

The organisation will be the scientific leader for the development of project's outputs, focusing on the contents and making sure that the materials that will be produced will respond to the actual needs of young girls and boys, their parents and educators. They have a long-standing experience on educational activities for the prevention of alcohol abuse and other risky behaviours among young people. They are staffed with psychologists, pedagogists and doctors who are able to address the subject of the project in a holistic way, taking into account all facets of the problem.

In addition, AIDD will be responsible for the creation of media products, such as the logo and website of the project, the videos included in IO1, the graphic editing of all materials produced by partners.

In a nutshell, AIDD will ensure a proper communication and production of project's intellectual outputs and messages, both from a content and graphic point of view.

Reasons of involvement in the project

AIDD wishes to put its experience at the service of youth beyond its local and regional communities, as the topic of alcohol use and abuse is more and more urgent to be tackled both at national and European level. However, to be effective, it is fundamental to have specific guidance, which AIDD is well placed to provide.

AIDD is willing to contribute to the education of European youth for a healthy and happy life, free of risky and negative behaviours.

Contact Person's Experience and Expertise

Franco Crippa Past President of AIDD and member of the board of AIDD. He has been company executive and management consultant for large multinational companies. He has chaired of the 59 School District in Lombardy Region from 1996 to 2013, carrying out school guidance projects for thousands of students. He founded the no-profit DSS9-Orienta association that carries out services and activities of orientation and reorientation for students and professionals.

Stefano Sgarella works as video producer, editor and director for various Italian universities, public institutions, foundations and no-profit associations, specializing in projects with social and educational backgrounds. Since 2010 he has been actively collaborating with the International Labor Organization for the international campaign against the exploitation of child labor. He is part of the Board of Directors of AIDD.

Anna Muntoni is a psychologist and psychotherapist working with teenagers and adults. Graduated in Clinical and Health Psychology, she has specialized in New Addiction Psychology. She has collaborated with associations and private centers that deal with substances dependence and behavioral addictions (e.g. internet and video games addiction, gambling addictions, emotional addiction), with a focus on adolescence and social withdrawal (Hikikomori). The clinical activity has oriented her training towards an integrated model, which allows to decline the therapeutic approach according to needs and singularity of patients.

Alberto Parola is Professor of Experimental Pedagogy at the Department of Philosophy and Educational Sciences of the University of Turin. He also teaches Methodology of Mediaeducational Research and Technologies of Education and Learning. He has experience in developing multimedia products (television formats and distance learning courses) and was part of the group of experts of the European project Emedus - European Media Literacy Education Study. Currently, he is President of the Interdepartmental Research Center for Cinema, Education and Media of the University of Turin (Cinedumedia).

Veronica Gariboldi is a graphic and web designer and photographer working with artists and no-profit associations. She delivers tailor-made projects taking care of all the stages of the design process, from brainstorming to the realization. She has an experience in the management of international projects addressing social and educational issues.

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Description of the organisation

The school is located in the city of Milan. It receives cultural stimuli and has chances to receive proposals from the municipality, universities and Onlus Organizations, parishes and associations present in its area. The Comprehensive school consists of 3 levels of schools (kindergarten, primary school and high school first level) about 945 students in total aged 3 to 14. It is attended by a very diversified population in terms of country of origin and culture. The fact the school covers three levels of education allows us to play an important supportive role to a large territory area, coherently where each action and intervention are connected to specific education and teaching choices, granting seamless paths: alignment activities, inclusion and orienting paths and activities to prevent early school leaving. In the school we have Special Educational Needs, Differently Abled, Specific Learning Disorders cases. The presence of students with diverse cultural roots leads to an opportunity of growth and personal enrichment for everyone. It sustains the spread of tolerance and solidarity values, against bias and with an open approach to integration ideas. Our educative plans provide disciplinary teaching programs and many projects and activities across disciplines. Multi-culture realities, active civic experiences, active and cooperating learning are highly valued. The approximate number of staff is about 130 including teachers and administration, most of them with a permanent work contract.

Experience of the organization in previous European projects

Our school has been involved at local, national and European level in inclusion projects, which shows that our school has a permanent concern for hospitality and inclusion. In 2018 we realized the project "A territorial center for security in the urban context of Cristobal (Colombia)", in collaboration with a school in Bogotá (Colombia) about the issues of hygienic environment safety. In November 2019 we had a job-shadowing experience with a Maths Teacher from Spain. She worked in our school for one week. Our staff has teachers who attended training courses and some of them coordinate activities with expert about alcohol prevention with preadolescent. Some teachers worked in Comenius Projects. In the school we are used to roll out actions and research activities internally. We are used to document the methodology best practices and make them available to all colleagues who are interested.

The school has a valid e-Twinning school project and rolled out many experiences of activity and project exchange with other Italian and European schools.

It has welcome other foreign delegation visiting Italian schools. In September 2019 the school was visited by 35 representative members of Korean Schools from Seoul in order to know and experience Italian school system.

Experience and Expertise of the organization in the project's subject area

The multi-culture reality where our school is set requires us to be teachers always searching carefully for methodologies and strategies functional to an harmonious growth of our students. Our school is based on inclusive approach education like one of the main elements of the path that leads to the educational success. We have worked in many projects in partnership with the non-governmental organization and agencies, such as AIDD, Mission Bambini, Fondazione Monserrate, with the purpose of inclusion through welfare and wellbeing at school in order to realize our main educational mission: "no one left behind". Projects for the integration of students with disabilities and special needs or disadvantaged social condition: Safety education. Helping students to prevent gambling, alcohol or internet addiction. Parents are also involved in these programmes. The school has participated to projects in network with European Schools and to job-shadowing experiences Project "Polo Start" realize activities for pupils coming from foreign countries, most of them from Asian and Arabian areas. It also manage Italian language teaching courses for foreign students and translation service for families.

Contributions that can be provided to the project

Our school has been involved at local, national and European level in inclusion projects to help young learners and preadolescent to improve their wellbeing at school and with families and friends. Which shows that our school has a permanent concern for hospitality and inclusion. The teachers involved in the project had experience in the themes of the project and other similar topics. The main subject areas of these projects are: multicultural education, health, language learning, youthful discomfort and cyber bullying, safety education. They developed some of them with their students and families. They also joined other international projects and will help contact with partners, organize mobility and all activities.

Reasons of involvement in the project

We work to help students to practice active citizenship experiencing solidarity and service learning, voluntary activities, knowledge of social problems, respect and care of themselves, others and environment. All these activities are included in the school curriculum and there are connections. There is a wide.

Contact Person's Experience and Expertise

Monica Aloise is Principal at ICS Scialoia since 2017. She worked as a teacher in secondary schools in Rome and Milan from 1999 to 2013. In 2014 she started working as a principal in comprehensive school in Milan. She has constantly been interested in European studies and school systems. She participated in European experiences and projects visiting many schools in different European countries: England, Finland, Poland, Romania, Spain, Greece. She works to improve European and international culture in school and involve teachers in European projects and training courses.

Emilia Pavone works as teacher of Italian Language and Literature at ICS Scialoia since 2008. She has been coordinator in many educational projects with pupils and colleagues. She is also the coordinator of the Secondary School.

Roberto Russo works as teacher of Mathematics and Science at ICS Scialoia since 2018. He has been coordinator in many projects involving students and families. He also works in projects with experts of local associations about themes such as diversity, inclusion and immigration. In 2019 he worked as coordinator of the "Bando Quartieri Project" which was about photography workshop and inclusion activities. He also managed the activities for the school in the video making workshop in a project for documenting social poverty in the outskirts of a big city. He supports the management of projects as coordinator and member of team helping also getting in touch with the partnership.

Loris Rossi is a musician and a teacher of music. He is also a teacher for pupils with special needs. He participates to European projects with Universities and International Schools. He will support the management of project as coordinator and member of the school team helping also getting in touch with partners.
